


God ordains the Passover • Exodus 11:1-13:22

Looking Forward to the Lamb of God


Match each description of a sacrifice to the corresponding picture.




The Passover sacrifice showed that deliverance from sin and from God's wrath comes only through the death of a perfect sacrifice.
